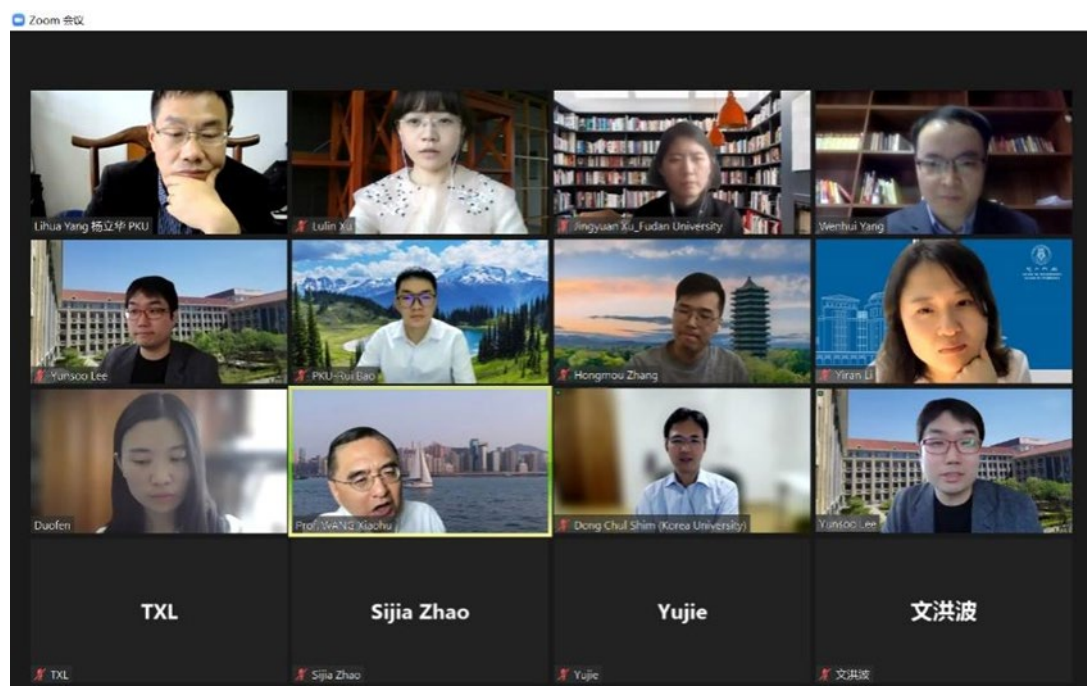
Digital Governance Research Team Releases Research Report "*Next Steps*" : *Digital Empowered Governance Collaboration*
